**ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION**

**Golf Outing Partnership**

Director Wehby advised that staff is proposing a shared golf outing fundraiser at Traditions at Chevy Chase in an effort to expand the partnership with School District 21 and generate additional funds to support the Family Learning Program. This potential event was discussed with representatives from the School District and received their support. The golf outing would be led by Park District staff, with assistance from School District 21.

The Committee discussed the proposal, and thought the partnership was a great idea. Commissioner Kurgan suggested keeping the entry fee below \$100 because of the current tight economic situation.

It was agreed that staff should move forward with developing a partnership agreement with School District 21 for an August 10, 2010, golf outing at Traditions at Chevy Chase, and bring the agreement to the full Board for approval at a future meeting.

**Family Learning Program Update**

Mr. Crocker gave an update on the Family Learning Program partnership. Items he addressed were after-school programs at the CRC, Cooper, Holmes, and London Schools; Harper College partnership; Colonial neighborhood event on February 20; early childhood ECDEC event on April 16; Buffalo Grove High School after-school program; and summer programs for students.
