

**ORDINANCE 2018-C
OF THE
WHEELING PARK DISTRICT
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

RE: DECLARATION OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZATION FOR SALE OR DISPOSAL

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board of Commissioners of the Wheeling Park District it is no longer necessary or useful to, or in the best interest of, the Park District to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it is determined by the Board of Commissioners that such personal property is declared surplus, and shall be disposed of in the manner stipulated below; and

WHEREAS, at least three-fifths (3/5) of the Board of Commissioners of the Wheeling Park District finds that the said property is no longer necessary or useful to the Park District's current needs or operations and is thereby considered as surplus property, but that revenue acquired from its sale can be applied to the purchase of similar equipment or other materials needed by the Park District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE WHEELING PARK DISTRICT, COOK AND LAKE COUNTIES, STATE OF ILLINOIS as follows:

SECTION 1: That pursuant to authority granted to the Park District under 70 ILCS 1205/8-22, the following described personal property now owned by the Wheeling Park District, is no longer necessary and useful to the Park District, and in the best interest of the Park District it will be disposed of in the most appropriate manner benefiting the Park District.

SECTION 2: The Board of Commissioners authorizes and directs the Executive Director to take such action necessary to dispose of the Property, as herein authorized by law, in the most appropriate manner benefiting the Park District.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from, and after, its adoption as provided by law.
