

**ORDINANCE 2004-J  
OF THE  
WHEELING PARK DISTRICT**

**RE: AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2004 OF THE WHEELING PARK DISTRICT OF COOK AND LAKE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS OF THE WHEELING PARK DISTRICT OF COOK AND LAKE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the sum of FOUR MILLION NINE HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$4,923,637) be and the same is hereby assessed and levied for and against all of the real property within the limits of this Park District, as the same is assessed and equalized for said taxes, for the year 2004, said total levy being for the various purposes of this Park District more particularly set forth:

SECTION 2. That the taxes so levied and assessed as set forth by this Ordinance upon the taxable property subject to taxes within the limits of this Park District, shall be collected and enforced in the same manner and by the same officers as general taxes are now collected and enforced for city and village purposes in the Counties of Cook and Lake, State of Illinois, and shall be paid over by the officers so collected the same to be Treasurer of this Park District.

SECTION 3. That the Secretary of this Park District be and is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Cook and Lake Counties, Illinois, within the time limit prescribed by law, a certified copy of this Ordinance.


SECTION 4. If any item or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.






**CERTIFICATE OF PRESIDING OFFICER**
